What Makes a Good Church Good?

What constitutes a good church? Is it the music? The youth programs? What about the preaching? And what exactly about the preaching? What's the difference between good preaching and bad preaching?

Biblically and theologically, what makes a good church a good church?

Over the next three months, we'll explore these exact sorts of questions and more in what could be one of the most important sermon series I'll ever preach at Westfield Baptist Church. What we discover and subsequently put into practice from this series will likely shape the future of our church culture, vision, strategy, and mission.

In anticipation of this sermon series, I commend to you the book *Nine Marks of a Healthy Church* by Mark Dever. The healthy "marks" in Dr. Dever's book aren't ultimately original to him. They're first taught in the Bible, of course, and have since been celebrated and practiced throughout the centuries in churches of all shapes, sizes, and traditions. What makes Dr. Dever's book particularly helpful, however, is how he succinctly describes a healthy church under the heading of nine distinct marks:

Expositional Preaching: Faithfully interpreting and proclaiming the Word of God.
 Biblical Theology: Understanding and teaching the grand narrative of Scripture.
 A Biblical Understanding of the Good News: Grasping the true essence of the gospel.

4. **A Biblical Understanding of Conversion:** Recognizing the transformation that comes with true faith.

5. **A Biblical Understanding of Evangelism:** Sharing the gospel effectively and authentically.

6. **A Biblical Understanding of Membership:** Valuing and committing to the local church body.

7. Biblical Church Discipline: Maintaining the purity and integrity of the church.
8. A Concern for Discipleship and Growth: Encouraging spiritual growth and maturity.

9. **Biblical Church Leadership:** Establishing leadership that aligns with scriptural principles.

These marks are fundamental to being a good and healthy church and, I believe, will prove essential as we grow to understand our nature and purpose as a church.

As we embark on this journey together, I encourage you to engage deeply with these topics. What we learn and implement will not only shape our present but will also pave the way for a vibrant and faithful future at Westfield Baptist Church. This series is an invitation to reflect, grow, and commit to being a church that takes membership seriously, loves one another deeply, serves our community meaningfully, stewards God's resources carefully, strives for personal and corporate holiness vigorously, expounds God's Word thoroughly, and seeks to glorify God pervasively in all things.

Join us as we explore what it means to be a *good* Church.


