These topics have painted a picture of what a truly biblical church looks like, and I believe that we, as Westfield Baptist Church, are committed to aligning ourselves with these scriptural teachings.

Any yet, I think I speak for most when I say that change is hard. Sometimes, even the mention of something new or unknown can be perceived as threatening and dangerous. That is why we must always return to God's word. What does the Bible say, what does the Bible say, what does the Bible say? May that become for us an anthem as we seek to honor the Lord in all that we do: what does the Bible say?

And while change is hard, that doesn't mean that it has to be quick. Rightly or wrongly, my personality is one of putting everything on the table. This Good Church series has been my equivalent of putting it all out there. Do I hope that our church will eventually align with the truths I've preached on now for weeks? Most certainly. Do I have any expectations of us arriving to that alignment any time soon? I have none. It is key that we all exercise patience. I ask for your patience as I learn the particulars of pastoring here in Westfield, and I commit to extend patience to you, as I recognize that some of these biblical doctrines and concepts are new to many.

Now, let me share with you a most encouraging word: a church that models itself after the New Testament Church is attractive. People are drawn to a church that believes like the Bible says to believe, prays as the Bible would have us pray, sings as the Bible commands us to sing, and preaches as the Bible instructs us to preach. And I am confident that as we commit to being a biblical church, church growth will follow naturally—not because we're chasing numbers, but because people notice a church that takes God's Word seriously. Faithfulness is the goal. Growth is the byproduct.

So let me be clear, we are already a good church, but our aim is to become an even better one. One that believes what God says, obeys what He commands, and reflects the beauty of His truth to the world around us.

Let us press on together, trusting that God will guide and bless us as we seek to be a faithful, biblical, good church.
